Seniors may have an opportunity to purchase a reserved parking spot (\$40) in the senior parking lot ONLY. Student may NOT purchase a reserved spot without having a current school parking permit. These spots will be given on a first come, first serve basis. There are ONLY 93 PARKING SPOTS available. If a student receives a reserved spot, this spot is only reserved for an individual between the hours of 7:30 am and 3:00 pm (Monday-Friday).

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- I will only use WATER BASED INTERIOR OR EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT (no reflective paint, no fluorescent paint, no spray paint, and no sealant)
- I will only paint within the parking space that I have received and I will never paint elsewhere
- I understand that I must provide my own paint and painting supplies
- I will only paint school appropriate designs that have been pre-approved (see painting guidelines)
- I will clean up all of my painting materials and trash when I am finished
- I understand that I may not park in someone else's reserved parking spot

If I do not abide by all of these rules, I understand that my parking spot will be taken away, painted over, and that I will not receive a refund.

Reserved Senior Parking Lot Spaces

Painting Guidelines

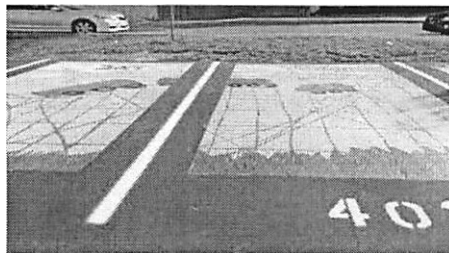
1. Student may **ONLY** paint their assigned parking spot
2. Students must **PROVIDE** and **USE WATER BASED INTERIOR OR EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT** (no reflective paint, no fluorescent paint, no spray paint, and no sealant) (You may want to consider sharing paint with your classmates)
3. Do not use "Striping Paint" or any other "Raised" paint or Roofing Tar - it either peels up or is difficult to paint over next year
4. The paint must stay between the parking lines
5. The assigned parking number must be present at the **bottom of the parking spot** (students may repaint the number into the design) (See sample)
6. Painting blueprint/sketch must be **SUBMITTED** and **APPROVED** by the Dean of Students
7. You may use **YOUR NAME** on your parking spot, a nickname must be approved.

Prohibited Items

- No offensive language, pictures, or symbols.
- No negative or rude language (Be nice).
- No "gang-style tagging."
- No double entendre's (Double meanings).
- No alcohol, tobacco, or drug symbols/words/paraphilia
- No political driven or religious

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the school administration. Disciplinary action may be taken and you may forfeit your right to a parking space.

***Notice the assigned number at the bottom of the parking spot!



Timeline of Events

8/12/19 and on: Download & Print Application/Contract or Pick up Application/Contract

Applications are located on the school website or in the dean's office. Students will need to fill out the contract, get a parent signature, and design their parking spot.

8/13/19-8/16/19: Turn Application/Contract & Parking Lot Design (Dean's Office 12:00pm - 3:00pm)

- (1) Students need to turn in their application/contract
- (2) Receipt of payment for your parking permit and parking spot from bookkeeping
***Reserved senior parking spots must be paid by cash/check to the bookkeeper, not on-line.**
- (3) A copy of the parking spot design for approval

The Dean of Students will keep a copy of your parking spot design, so make a copy for yourself. The Dean of Students will contact you, if the design is unacceptable or if any changes are required.

***Seniors may obtain a spot throughout the remainder of the week in the Dean's office, if they are unable to attend registration.

Parking Lot Painting Day(s):

Friday, August 16 from 3:15 pm -6:15 pm (*weather permitting*)

Saturday, August 17 from 8:00 – 12:00 noon (*weather permitting*)

**** If weather impacts the scheduled painting days, an additional day will be added for those who may miss out on an opportunity to paint their designated spot.*

Step 1: Verify your reserved parking spot number with the Dean of Students

Step 2: Prepare all of your painting supplies (paintbrushes, paint, painter's tape, a gallon of water, etc.) in front of your parking spot

Step 3: Bring a broom to sweep off your spot before painting

Step 4: Paint your parking spot

Step 5: Clean up your supplies and area
