

Interested in an Honors or AP Math Class at AAHS?

Are you...

- ...currently in Geometry and interested in taking Honors Algebra 2 next year?
- ...currently in Honors Algebra 2 interested in skipping Algebra 3 to take AP Precalculus next year?
- ...currently in Algebra 2 or Algebra 3 and interested in AP Precalculus next year?
- ...an *Honors or Advanced Mathematics Thinker*?

If so, here is what to do:

Honors/Advanced Math placement test information

1. **All students** currently in Geometry and Honors Algebra 2 at Air Academy will take the Advanced Math Placement Test with their current math teacher during a class period in February.
2. Students in Algebra 2 or Algebra 3 at Air Academy who are interested in AP Precalculus need to **schedule** to take the Advanced Math placement test by contacting their current math teacher.
3. Students transferring to AAHS next year who are interested in either Honors Algebra 2, but did **NOT** attend Eagleview Middle School or who are interested in AP Precalculus but did **NOT** attend Air Academy High School previously will be asked to schedule a time to take the Advanced Math Placement Test when they register for their classes.
4. Students need to bring a pencil and calculator for the test. The test consists of multiple-choice questions (calculator allowed) and free response/short answer questions (no calculator allowed) in which students need to show work.
5. After testing, your score along with current and previous math grades, MAPS and PSAT scores, and other data will be evaluated by the Math Department in order to make a recommendation for next year. The recommendation will be sent to your current math teacher; see your current teacher to discuss results and determine what course is the correct placement for you. Recommendations for transfer students will be sent to their AAHS counselor.
